- Bachelor's degree or higher in any field
- Native English ability
- Citizenship from a country where the official language is English

Job Description & Responsibilities:

- Actively communicate and cooperate with a multi-national staff on projects, lessons, and events
- Teach English to both children and adults at our school
- Teach English lessons outside of our school
 - Kindergartens, nursery schools, culture centers, universities, companies, etc.

- Plan lessons and prepare conversation activities for lessons
- Plan and participate in all school events
 - Elementary students' performances, seasonal events, textbooks fairs, etc.
- Participate in planning and making materials to be published

Contract, Remuneration, Benefits & Holidays:

The successful candidate will be offered a contract through March 2020 or 2021 with the option to renew for the next academic year and a salary based on teaching experience and overall performance.
